Background

- EB 88 considered the concept note containing inter alia, possible new approaches that may be incorporated into the "Guidelines for the establishment of sector specific standardized baselines" (SB Guideline);
- EB88 agreed not to further work on the SB Guideline;
- EB 89 requested the MP to incorporate clarifying elements, as previously included in the concept note, without revising any of the existing approaches in the guideline.
- The revised version was sent for Public Call at MP72.



The proposed revisions

The clarifying elements on

- a) The definition of terms used in the Guideline;
- b) Clarification on the available approaches for SB development;
- c) Clarification on the existing approach (e.g., elaboration on level of aggregation, positive list etc);
- d) Clarification on possible use of combination of SB and methodologies in order to cover the targeted measures;
- e) Clarification on the data vintage used for SB development;
- f) Clarification on the consideration of investment analysis and/or barrier analysis while deriving the positive list in the existing approach;
- g) Illustrative example for the application of the existing approach.



Recommendations to the Board

The Meth Panel recommends that the Board adopt this final draft guideline.
