Providing mandate to revise "AMS-II.E: Energy efficiency and fuel switching measures for buildings"

- **Baseline**
 - a) **Retrofit measures:** energy baseline consists of the energy use of the existing equipment that is replaced;
 - b) **New facility:** energy baseline consists of the facility that would otherwise be built.

- **Monitoring Methodology**
 - a) **Retrofit measures:** documenting the specifications of the equipment replaced, and calculating the energy savings due to the measures installed;
 - b) **New facility:** metering the energy use of the building(s) and calculating the energy savings of the new building(s).



Clarification SSC_CLA_751

- Clarification SSC_CLA_751: application of **AMS-II.E** and the **TOOL31** (Determination of standardized baselines for energy efficiency measures in residential, commercial and institutional buildings)
 - Three issues: (i) monitoring the change in appliances, (ii) use of different approaches to determine the grid emission factor, and **(iii) use of other methods to determine project emissions**
- MP 79: clarified that project participants can **propose equations** to estimate baseline and project emissions, as long as they are **in line with the provisions** of AMS-II.E. to determine emission reductions, and the provisions shall be **validated by a DOE**.
- For the benefit of future users, MP recommends equations are provided.
